So our request is that this actity, if considered correct, must be recognized with a memorandum of understanding." These the words of Massimo Barra, founder of Villa Maraini, during the meeting, who mentioned the pre-arrest deflection

practiced in the U.S., as a valid alternative to punitive measures for people with drug disorder met in the street by law enforcement.
